



Distributed Energy Resource (DER) Register

DER Connection Process

Step 1

Customer chooses a DER, like solar for example

Step 2

Customer/Installer/Electrical Contractor or Solar Retailer submits a network connection application form via the Connections Portal to TasNetworks (the application form now includes the additional fields required for the DER Register)

Step 3

TasNetworks approves the application for connection of the DER. This approval may be conditional

Step 4

DER installation proceeds by the installer

Step 5

The installer submits an EWR (Electrical Works Request) via the connections portal. The electricity retailer installs or updates the meter
The installer commissions the DER

Step 6

Installer/Electrical Contractor provides TasNetworks with As-built information within 5 business days from installation date via the connections portal

Step 7

DER system in operation
