CEO announces departure

TasNetworks CEO Seán Mc Goldrick has announced today that he will be leaving the business on 30 June 2026.

TasNetworks Chair Roger Gill said Dr Mc Goldrick had chosen to move on as his contract is coming to an end.

“Having been with the business for five years, Seán has been instrumental in ensuring we are in the best position to provide safe and sustainable delivery of electricity for Tasmanians,” Mr Gill said.

“Whether it be through our transformation process, or most recently by supporting the progress of the North West Transmission Developments (NWTN), Seán has left a positive lasting legacy.”

Mr Gill said the TasNetworks Board had asked Executive People and Stakeholder Renée Anderson to step in as Acting CEO following Dr Mc Goldrick’s departure and while a formal process is underway for the recruitment of a new CEO. She will work closely with Dr Mc Goldrick for the next few months to support the transition.

“The Board would like to take this opportunity to thank Seán for his commitment and ability to drive the business forward during his tenure,” Mr Gill said

Mr Gill said Seán will continue to play a key role in the business until June with the NWTN now in the next important phase of the project as it heads towards a decision on Financial Close over the coming weeks.
