

## TasNetworks Waiver Register

This register is maintained and made publicly available in accordance with clause 5.7(a) of the Australian Energy Regulator's (AER) Ring Fencing Guideline (**Guideline**).

The Guideline was effective from 1 December 2016 with a transition period during which Distribution Network Service Providers (**DNSPs**) were required to implement the necessary controls to ensure compliance with the Guideline. Full compliance was required no later than 1 January 2018. To manage transitional issues, DNSPs were able to seek waivers from certain obligations from the AER.

The table below sets out a register of all waivers granted to TasNetworks, and includes a description of the conduct to which the waiver applies, expiry date and clauses waived.
